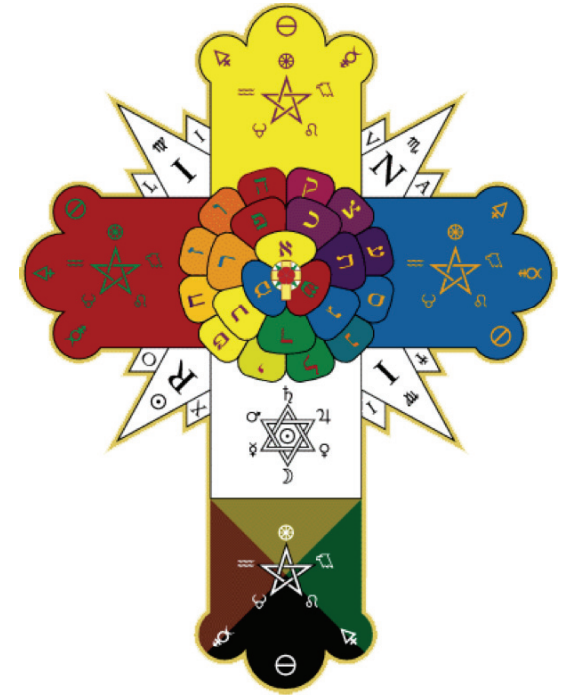
of the Society of the Inner Light, through Ernest Butler, the founder of the Servants of the Light and Dolores

COST

VENUE

The workshops take place at a central London location within easy access of rail, tube and bus. Full details will be provided upon acceptance of your application. Workshops run from 09.30am until 9.30pm each day, with an hour lunch break and a 90-minute dinner break. Registration and coffee is from 09.15am. Each one-day workshop ends with a simple ritual, in which you are invited to participate.
